



POSITION DESCRIPTION: City Life Director (Near North Side)

SUPERVISOR'S TITLE: City Life Ministry Director (Currently Executive Director)

POSITION SUMMARY: The role of the City Life Director is to be a minister of the Gospel and engage adults in authentic Christ-sharing relationships with lost teens. This should be accomplished through modeling direct ministry with teens, coordinating opportunities for volunteers to enter in to the lives of teens, and supporting/training those volunteers in their ministry roles. The City Life Director is responsible for the growth and development of the City Life Core ministry, on the Near North Side of Indianapolis.

#### PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Lead the City Life ministry through the 5 Essentials
- Lead an extensive programming model in the neighborhood of clubs, events, camp, small groups, mentoring and leadership development
- Liaison with the City Life Wheels, JJM and Parent Life Directors
- Develop ministry with neighborhood partners and churches
- Develop ministry with school partners
- Build a ministry based on the City Life white paper
- Assist with funding for the City Life ministry and program, through speaking engagements, grants and personal appointments.
- Recruit, train, empower and retain a robust volunteer team
- Train church teams and community in inner city youth issues
- Lead the ministry leaders and volunteers in the Unified focus, developing authentic Christ sharing relationships
- Spiritually lead students and Leaders through prayer and bible study

#### EXPECTATIONS

- Must be a fully committed follower of Jesus Christ, actively growing closer and deeper in relationship with Him.
- Should strive for a high personal level of godly character and Christian values.
- Be a participating member of a local church.
- Must be in agreement with YFC's Statement of Faith.
