



POSITION: City Life Site Director | Full Time

POSITION SUMMARY: The role of the City Life Site Director is to be a minister of the Gospel and engage adults in authentic Christ-sharing relationships with lost teens. This should be accomplished through modeling direct ministry with teens, coordinating opportunities for volunteers to enter in to the lives of teens, and supporting/training those volunteers in their ministry roles. The City Life Site Director is responsible for the growth and development of the City Life program in a specific neighborhood.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Lead an extensive programming model in the neighborhood of clubs, events, camp, small groups, mentoring and leadership development
- Liaison with the City Life, City Life Wheels, JJM and Parent Life Directors
- Develop ministry with neighborhood partners and churches
- Develop ministry with school partners
- Assist with funding for the City Life ministry and program, through speaking engagements, grants and personal appointments
- Recruit, train, empower and retain a robust volunteer team
- Train church teams and community in inner city youth issues
- Lead the ministry leaders and volunteers in the Unified Focus, developing authentic Christ sharing relationships
- Spiritually lead students and leaders through prayer and bible study

EXPECTATIONS

- Must be a fully committed follower of Jesus Christ, actively growing closer and deeper in relationship with Him
- Should strive for a high personal level of godly character and Christian values
- Be a participating member of a local church
- Must be in agreement with YFC's Statement of Faith
- Must live or be willing to relocate to the ministry area
- The candidate will have an extensive understanding of under-resourced neighborhoods and diversity awareness
