

The City Life Wheels Director is responsible for giving leadership to and fulfilling the Youth for Christ (YFC) vision and mission through the City Life Wheels outreach program. This includes leadership to the facilities, community support team, to volunteers of the facility, to fund and create community development activities, and to the ministry outreach guided by the 5 Essentials of YFC and Relational Ministry Actions.

Essential Job Functions and Duties

Community Support Team Building:

The Director is expected to work in partnership with the Support Team in the development of ministry, community, and financial support within the region, and shall work to build a strong team.

Volunteer Development:

The Director shall continually seek to build ministry in the region through the body of Christ. The Director shall place high priority on finding volunteers to work together as a team to provide ministry as needed.

Ministry Effectiveness:

The Director shall see that the gospel message is effectively presented at every possible opportunity. All activities, events, concerts, trips, clubs, training, etc., shall be planned and executed with the primary goal of sharing the life changing message of the gospel. The main connection with young people is through the daily activities through car repair and training.

Fundraising:

The Director shall see it as his/her responsibility to maintain and continually develop the funding base for this ministry. The Director will need to develop and maintain many adult relationships throughout the assigned region. Seeking direct financial support from adults is the highest priority in building a local funding base.

Community Relations:

The Director shall serve as an advocate for youth evangelism in the community, supporting all efforts to mobilize the Christian community to reach lost youth. The Director shall see that YFC and its mission have visibility in the community, and that YFC works in a cooperative manner with churches, other youth evangelism organizations, and community/civic groups.

Administration/Car Repair Projects:

The Director is expected to handle necessary management of: volunteer training, ministry events, fundraising events, and community relations events and car repair projects.

Personal Growth:

It is our desire that you excel - in your ministry and personally - and the key is to commit your heart to love God and seek Him first, above anything. The Director will be expected to spend daily time in prayer and Bible study, actively participate in a home church (you are strongly encouraged to attend church within your ministry area), and maintain social relationships that will not hinder spiritual growth.

Leadership Qualifications and Requirements

The City Life Wheels Director must be credentialed by YFC/USA, or be in the process of gaining credentials and meet YFC's initial and continuing training requirements. The CLD is also a professional position that requires the following skills in order to fulfill the vision and mission of YFC:

- Exemplary Christian life and spiritual leadership as a follower of Jesus
- Ability to build and maintain healthy relationships with people
- Competent in time management, planning, problem solving, and conflict resolution
- Capability of doing discipleship evangelism ministry within the context of relationships, shared activities, and large and small groups
- Ability to rally and lead people in the mission of YFC and raise the necessary funds to support the Chapter
- Ability to work with and serve people from various Christian traditions
- Willingness and ability to build and manage multiple teams of people

Bachelor's Degree is preferred. Emphasis in youth ministry, Bible or education/social services related field preferred. A Background in car Mechanics and the ability to teach skills to young people in the program (ASE Certification preferred)
